This month started with an intense, quick visit to Miami and

Cuba. We were able to connect with Manny Noriega in Miami Lakes and share the prayer seminar. It was a blessing to meet his leaders and church. Then we met with Vic Pease and his team from Maine and traveled to



Santiago, Cuba. The expected challenge for us was the rolling blackouts, but that did not deter the team. In the end, we only had a total of 30 minutes during the 4 days without electricity. Praise the Lord! It was a comfortable 90°F plus 100% humidity, for those who were wondering about the weather! (wink, wink).

The team visited a hospital with medical supplies. They were well received especially since there is a scarcity



of supplies. Then it was off to the baseball fields to minister to the children. They were so excited to receive the donated sporting equipment! The next stop was the men's softball games where more supplies were distributed. Due to the intense financial crises in the country, there is no money to buy sporting equipment, even if you can find it to buy! But the one thing that was in overabundance was the love of Christ as we shared the Gospel in all these places. Many souls were led to Christ and the local pastors/churches were there to meet the new believers to help them grow in their faith with discipleship. The days passed quickly as we were tired, but joyful. We were amazed by the Cuban church as they are so vibrant even without money, supplies or electricity. Paul said there would be suffering and tribulation, but the Word of the Lord will have free course to work in the hearts of people. (2 Timothy 2:9)

After returning from Cuba, Adam was able to share the prayer seminar in Hyattsville, MD, in the church where we ministered together during our seminary days.
